CAMPUS CHILD CARE

Azalea Child Care Center –
Traditional child care center with 46 slots for children 6 weeks-5 years. Operated by Bright Horizons.

Beaver Beginnings –
Traditional child care center with 144 slots for children ages 6 weeks-5 years. Operated by KinderCare.

Dixon Kits Early Care & Education Center –
Traditional child care center with 12 slots for children ages 6 weeks-2.5 years. Operated by OSU.

Our Little Village – Milne & Dixon
Short-term child care offered throughout the week, including evening and weekend hours, for children ages 5 months- 12 years. This program is free at time of service to students paying the student incidental fee. Employees will be charged a minimal fee for the service. 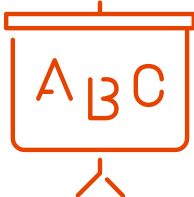

Child Care Assistance Programs:

Lactation Support: There are over 30 lactation rooms across campus available to students, employees and campus visitors in addition to other supports and resources. Traveling for work? Milk Stork is a free milk delivery service offered to OSU employees and students.
